



Welcome to the New Shipton Cricket 100 Club draw

A great way for you to support us whilst having a bit of a flutter! Here's how it works...

Complete and sign the attached membership form and set up a standing order mandate with your bank for **£20 a month or £240 annually**. Alternatively, you can pay by cheque.

This buys you one membership number (See the 100 board), which enters you into the draw. All participants must be over 16.

The draw will take place quarterly with a first prize of £1,000 and seven runners up prizes. Or an equivalent percentage if there are less than 100 members.

If you win, you will be paid directly, or a cheque will be posted to your home address and the name of the winner published on the **Club website, newsletter and noticeboard**.

The prize money will be **40%** of the membership fee taken that quarter. The remaining **60%** goes to the Club to help fund the building of the new clubroom.

100 club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the Club bank account and used to meet funding required for the new Clubroom.

Rules

1. For a cost of **£20** per month or £240 per year you will be allocated one number between one and 100.
2. A draw will be made every quarter with a 1st, 2nd and other prizes.
3. The prizes will total **40%** of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: **First prize £1,000 plus seven £200 prizes or a percentage thereof if less than 100 members at every quarterly draw.**
5. The 100 club is a private lottery and is open to all **parents, carers and friends of Shipton under Wychwood Cricket Club**. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
6. Numbers are limited to two per household.
7. Payments must be made by standing order either monthly or annually or by annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
8. The 100 Club member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
10. **The draw shall be made by our President at President's Day, the autumn dinner, the AGM and the first All Stars evening.**
11. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
12. The name and numbers for each quarter's winners will be posted in the Club newsletter and on the Club website.
13. The 100 club will be run by Shipton under Wychwood Cricket Club. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Club funds after six months.

GDPR

Shipton-under-Wychwood Cricket Club collects and uses your personal data (name, contact details and bank information) solely for administering the 100 Club, processing payments, and contacting you about draws or membership matters. Your data is stored securely and accessed only by authorised club officers. We do not share your information with third parties except for banking or legal requirements.
